FireSmart BC Home Evaluation

We've identified a few steps you can take to increase your property's protection from potential wildfires.



Clean and maintain gutters and roofs



Keep grass and weeds cut below 10 centimetres



Relocate propane, firewood and other fuel sources 10 to 30 metres away from structures



Prune trees to create a two-meter clearance from the ground to the lowest branches



Clean under your deck to remove any combustible material. Establish a 1.5 metre non-combustible zone around the perimeter of the house and deck



Reduce the flammability of your landscaping and plant wildfire resistant vegetation
