FireSmart™ BC Home Evaluation

We've identified a few steps you can take to increase your property's protection from potential wildfires.

- Clean and maintain gutters and roofs
- Keep grass and weeds cut below 10 centimetres
- Relocate propane, firewood and other fuel sources 10 to 30 metres away from structures
- Prune trees to create a two-meter clearance from the ground to the lowest branches
- Clean under your deck to remove any combustible material. Establish a 1.5 metre non-combustible zone around the perimeter of the house and deck
- Reduce the flammability of your landscaping and plant wildfire resistant vegetation
